## **CITI ADDS MORE TALENT TO SOUTH EAST ASIA BANKING TEAM**

### **Key hire to focus on Energy and Industrials clients**

**Hong Kong/Singapore:** Citi has appointed Abhay Pande as Head of South East Asia Industrials Global Banking. Pande's vast experience and global perspective will be invaluable to our clients," said Michael Borch.
